
I. PURPOSE:

It is the policy of this Department, in conjunction with the Regional Police Academy and the Georgia Police Academy, to train its officers in crime/accident scene responsibilities, and procedures.

II. RECRUIT TRAINING:

It shall be the responsibility of the Regional Police Academy to provide to basic Deputy Recruits the following described basic training responsibilities. A basic working knowledge of these described responsibilities will be covered.

1. Potentialities and limitations of the examinations of physical evidence.
2. Written directives concerning the role and function of the Investigator and the Patrol Deputy.
3. Collection methods and procedures regarding fingerprints, footprints, blood, fibers, fabrics, weapons, hairs, paint, glass, tool-marks and the requirements for comparison purposes.
4. Preservation methods for various forms of evidence.
5. Maintenance of the chain of custody with evidence, marking, custody of evidence, and records.
6. Crime Scene and Accident Sketch.
7. Crime and accident scene photography.
8. Crime or accident scene records.
